**They are coming to the April Council meeting to talk about how Montverde can adopt its own Emergency Plan in preparation for hurricane season. We hope that you will be able to attend.**

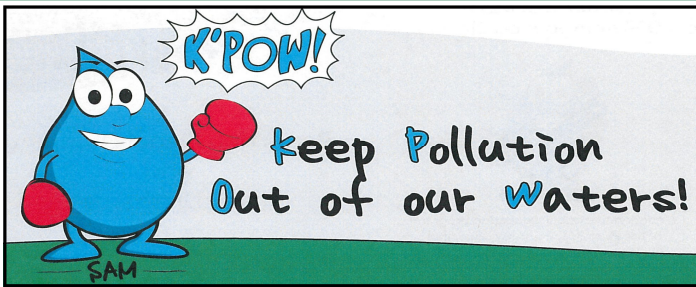

- First Reading of Ordinance 2016-02 - Amending the Code for Accessory Structures, Canopies and Sheds.
- Second Reading of Ordinance 2016-07 - Amending the Code for Building Setbacks from 25 feet to 15 feet.
