She went on to explain this is the next step to acquire the property that is needed for the Central Sewer and Wastewater Treatment Plant. She introduced attorney David Shontz a partner at Shutts & Bowen, LLP. Mr. Shontz explained the process of negotiating and eminent domain if a purchase price cannot be reached.

Town Manager Larino, explained the steps that we would do once the property is taken by the Town.
